To be devoted to a symbol of The Resurrection - a "The Phoenix" -
White rose border, to balance Lily.
We retained the steel divisions in the opposite windows.

The final and smaller window bears the traditional symbol of the Resurrection, the Phoenix arising anew from the flames of its nest.

The rose pattern of Divine Love forms the border.
