Center lancet - Entry into Jerusalem. Left East lancet Cleansing of the Temple. Right West lancet Jesus and His Enemies (Scribes and Pharisees).

Rector writes "This window as a whole should be designed in a style very similar to the one which you just completed which blends harmoniously with the other windows in the nave." See photograph of our first window and slides of other windows in the church.

This window goes opposite our earlier window. The center panel only has been taken. This will be referred to as the "Stevens Lancet".

*The making and installation of the central panel involves some problems in relation to the tracery and extra work of installation. If the central panel is made and installed at a separate time, I would suggest a cost of \$900 for it and the 2 tracery pieces immediately above. If the 4 triangles and the 2 quatrefoils,

walk in long robes, and love greetings in the markets.

were included, the cost should be \$1000. Then if the 2 outer panels with their tracery members were each installed at separate times, the cost could well be \$900 each. Of, if installed together, \$1700 for the pair. If the complete window were to be made and installed at the same time, the cost would still be \$2600.

As planned, it is devoted to the Cleansing of the Temple, the Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem, and Jesus and His enemies, - the Scribes and Pharisees.

The central panel, the Stevens memorial, represents the Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem. Our Lord rides the donkey under the symbol of the arch of the city entrance, while the group below welcome Him with palm branches.

The text of the memorial inscription may include the name and dates if required.

At the left, Our Lord casts out those who bought and sold in the Temple. Above is a symbol of the cleansed Temple enclosing the cross of salvation.

At the right, Our Lord opposed by His enemies is symbolized by the healing of the man with the withered hand on the Sabbath. Above are the Scribes and Pharisees taking counsel against Him. The symbol of the Scales, encircled by the net, recalls Our Lord's accusation of the Scribes and Pharisees, - "Ye have omitted the weightier matters of the Law, - Justice, Mercy, and Faith (Matthew 23:23).

The symbols in the quatrefoils of the tracery are the Star of David and the Kingly Crown, both recalling the salutations of the multitude at Our Lord's Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem.

The fields and borders are designed to harmonize with the neighboring windows.
