General Information..... To be made in a simple manner - to have symbols about the heavens declaring the glory of God - simple and luminous, as in Westminster Church, Lincoln, Nebraska. With carefully thought out proportions and leading. The medallions and border lines are in brilliant color in lightly tinted fields.

..... These are in the upper part of our entrance tower, they cannot be conveniently seen or observed from the entrance.

Design for typical pair ... "planned in even lighter glass (than the tall lancet over the main entrance devoted to the Welcoming Christ), but with sufficient brilliant color to balance the central window and to add a colorful note to the entire enrichment. They feature Angels of Praise and Prayer with trumpet and censer, - the heavens declaring the glory of God. The simple field is spotted with conventional cloud and star forms. The opposite pair would be somewhat similar.

This may be considerable enrichment for these windows; but I am inclined to think that their influence will be felt and appreciated even in their high position."
