General Information Te Deum - In a manner to complement and balance the chancel window.

We have also designed the Te Deum for the Nuns Gallery window representing Christ enthroned in the dominant position; David with his harp, Saint John the Baptist with his crossed staff, and the Blessed Virgin holding the Christ Child below, and prophets and saints at either side.

The Old Testament is represented at the left with the goodly fellowship of prophets, - Isaiah (with pen and scroll of prophecy), Jeremiah (broken chains), Ezekiel (burning torch), Daniel (lion).

The apostles and martyrs are at the right, - Saint Paul (sword and book), Saint Lawrence (grill), Saint Edmund (crown and sceptre and arrows) and Saint Thomas a Becket (mitre and sword).

Angels of Praise and Prayer with trumpet and censer, and other members of the Angelic Host with musical instruments enrich the tracery; with stars of Heavenly steadfastness in the smaller members and the Alpha and Omega in the quatrefoil at the top.

At the base is the text, - "All the earth doth worship thee, the Father everlasting."

This window is designed to harmonize with and complement the chancel window opposite.
