General Information These windows are in pairs - 22 inches between the panels.

Subjects of this pair to be - left panel, The Resurrection; right panel, The Crucifixion.

(See designs for the other two pairs already made.

Dr. Knickle likes blue. Windows to be similar to the clerestory windows in the main church. They especially like the colors in the Mellick window. Minimize the amount of yellow and emphasize the blues and reds. First two designs accepted.

*Resurrection or the Risen King.

The final pair for the Chapel series is devoted to the Crucifixion and the Resurrection.

In the first, Our Lord is represented on the cross, and in the second, His radiant figure comes forth from the dark tomb bearing the symbolic cruciform banner of victory.

~~In your earlier letters you referred to this window as the Resurrection, but in your last letter, you speak of the Risen King. We questioned this in our letter of October fifteenth, but as you did not clarify this question, we have kept the somewhat conventional Resurrection. If you prefer a crown and richer garments, we shall be glad to do it in that way.~~

The memorial inscription is roughly indicated, -
