We have completed our study of the design for your window devoted to The Transfiguration, and are sending you the rough color sketch, herewith.

Our Lord stands transformed on the mountain in garments of radiant white. At the left is Moses with the Tablets of the Law, and at the right, the Prophet Elias. The apostles, - Peter, James and John kneel below.

In harmony with the other windows, the theme is framed in decorative architectural "canopy", with adoring angels above.

A ribbon across the base bears the memorial inscription, -
Jennie Lucille Seymour / In Memoriam / Nellie Seymour Morris.
