General Information To be in the Waterville, Maine type, but simplified to meet the price. Stars in the border instead of the crowns, simplified foliated field - simplify a bit to get it down to the price. The minister likes the crosses - perhaps we can etch this to get the price down. Chi Rho in the center instead of the cross and crown, Alpha and Omega, at the sides, dove above, and book below with the words, "The Word Became Flesh".

They are going to have the sash made and give us the actual full and sight size.

Its general plan follows that of the window you liked.

At the center is the Chi Rho monogram, with the alpha and omega at either side, and the Descending Dove of the Holy Spirit above.

At the bottom is the open book inscribed with the text, "The Word became Flesh".

Crosses enrich the intermediate spaces, set in foliated pattern. Stars of heavenly steadfastness accent the four outer symbols.

It may be that the central symbol should be emphasized a bit more by making it larger, and the surrounding ones relatively smaller. If you agree, this can be worked out to best purpose in the full size drawings.
