General Information This is a new rather modernistic church.

The six side windows have a stationary section at the top, a horizontal division two inches wide, and then a casement section all in bronze frames.

Here the pastor would like to have the activities of the Church - Baptism, Confirmation, Marriage, Blessed Sacrament, and Burial or the Last Rites. He mentioned something to symbolize activities of the Church after Marriage and before burial. They apparently do not like much simple leaded fields; for instance he liked the Baptism panel at Saint Raphael's, New Orleans, if we blocked out the lower part.

Make typical sketch - Baptism.

With the thought of devoting the series to the activities of the Church including Confirmation, Marriage, the institution of the Blessed Sacrament and the Last Rites, this window is devoted to Baptism. The Priest stands holding the child before the font, with the parents and Godparents near by.
