This window will go opposite Saint Andrew.

We have completed our study of the window devoted to Saint Margaret of Scotland and are sending you the rough color sketch, herewith.

She is crowned as Queen and holds the black Cross which was part of her dowery. The boy beside her suggests her ransom of English captives.

The architectural implications through the border and at the top recall the Abbey she built at Dunfermline to house a relic of the cross, as well as the many churches she and her husband built.

Symbols in the border represent her sceptre and jeweled book of the Gospels, and the ladies embroidery guild she established to work on vestments and altar furnishings.

Near the base are her arms and her kneeling figure washing the feet of a pilgrim.

The memorial inscription reads: "To the Glory of God and in Loving Memory of Margaret Boweroux Sanders and David Tilden Sanders."
