General Information To have the Welcoming Christ - include little kneeling figures of an elderly couple - and perhaps figure of a young girl at prayer, to suggest the theme "Come unto me", ~~and ye who are heavy laden and~~ I will give ~~you~~ rest."

The window is given by a young lady of 17 in memory of her grandparents.

We have been studying the fascinating possibilities for the stair window and are sending you a very rough color suggestion for its design.

The figure of the Welcoming Christ with outstretched arms suggests the theme, - "Come unto me, all ye who are heavy laden and I will give you rest."

Small figures of an elderly couple in prayer are indicated in the field above, and a young lady, also kneeling in prayer, is designed in the field below, with a ribbon for the memorial text. The upper figures might be made a little larger.

The grapevine outlining the medallion and enriching the field suggests the unity and fruitfulness of the church through Our Lord's significant words, - "I am the vine ye are the branches."

The text at the base to read: "Come unto Me...and I will give you rest."
