General Information Pentecost (Blue).

They prefer the medallion in the aisle window at Church of the
Atonement, Westfield, Massachusetts.

(Note that the Mott's have already given one window - the
Transfiguration - so the inscription should
match that one).

The one nearest the chancel symbolizes Pentecost. The frame is seen at the forehead of each Apostle with the Descending Dove of the Holy Ghost above. Included is the inscription, - "In loving memory of Edith Mott".
