General Information To be devoted to Saint Michael, with attendant angels.  
Coloring to be about the same as the window below. Bluish armor, red wings, not too much white. (This is a memorial to Bishop Block.)

The window below this is the Nancy Block Memorial - St. Francis.

As planned, it is devoted to the Archangel Saint Michael with attendant Angels. Saint Michael is clothed in armor and surcoat and bears the scales and flaming sword. On his breast is his traditional cross. The members of the Angelic choir bear the trumpet of praise and the censer of prayer.

The window is designed to harmonize with the one below, and also with others in the clerestory. We are confident it will work out beautifully in the color and light of the actual glass, and we are eager to proceed with its development.
