General Information These panels to have simple fields, but with a certain amount of patterned texture to control the light, in the nature of the Bessemer Junior Choir Group, and Montclair, - textures like that to control the light, probably with little kneeling singing angels, - a little rectangular panels, simple like the attached sketch in pencil.

They want to keep them light, but at the same time they want to control the strong sun they receive.

We are to add a little more color. They suggest the addition of color around the border reds and blues. Send sketch back.

Window nearest chancel - Nativity, Second from chancel, Blessing Children.

We have revised and increased the color areas in the design for the choir window, and have lowered the tone of the light field. If you feel it should be even deeper we can very well do this in the actual glass, but we think it should not make the passage too dark. You can be sure we will study this very carefully in the actual glass.

3/25/59. Mr. Paulson says some of the people still think the sketch for the choir window is too light, but they think we should be the best judge, and they do not want to get ~~it~~ it too light to make it too different from the other windows, but not too dark.
