General Information This window is devoted to Enoch, Noah, Abraham and Isaac. Enoch at the center of the left-hand panel bears the shepherd's crook. Opposite, Noah holds the axe for building the ark. Below, Abraham at the left carries the knife and brazier of fire for the sacrifice, while Isaac at the right bears the sacrificial wood. Angels of Prayer and Praise with censer and trumpet are represented in the lancets' heads; and the choir of angels known as Principalities, holding a lily is symbolized in the tracery member.
