In the window devoted to the Ascension, the radiant figure of Our Lord rises above the Apostles. Above is the hand of God in blessing. Below is the Cross and Chi Rho symbol of Christ. The border is enriched with white fleur-de-lys of Purity, also suggesting the triumph over death.

As planned, one is devoted to the Ascension with the radiant figure of Our Lord rising above the Apostles. Below is the Cross and Chi Rho symbol of Christ.

The border is enriched with the white fleur-de-lis of Purity, also suggesting the triumph over death.

Another symbolizes Pentecost with the flames above the foreheads of the Apostles. Saint Peter is emphasized in the larger central figure. Below is the Descending Dove of the Holy Ghost, while the border is designed in a pattern of conventionalized clouds and stars.

The predominating colors, ruby and blue, take alternating positions in these two designs.
