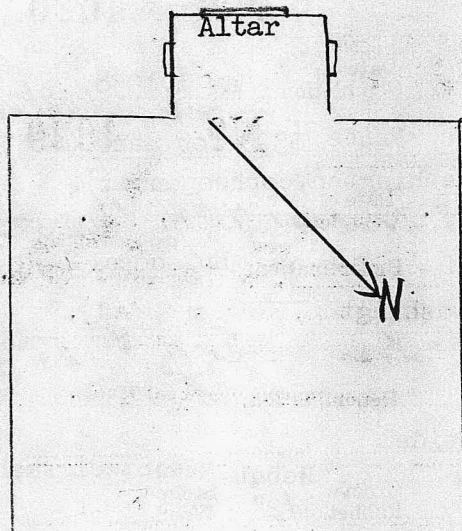

These windows to have a flower design - the rose in one, and the lily in the other - kept rather formal to harmonize with the designs in the side panels of the central chancel window.

Windows in memory of a former member of the Altar Guild, who was a great lover of flowers.



We have completed our study of the design for the two side chancel windows, and are sending you the rough color sketches herewith.

As planned, they symbolize in radiant color, the love of flowers. The rose is featured in one, and the lily in the other.

They are designed to harmonize with the central chancel window, with growing foliated patterns enriching the fields surrounding the dominant symbols.

A space is provided at the base for a memorial inscription.
