General Information The Temptation, The Baptism, and Calling Disciples. This is a red window.

Borders ~~red~~, fields ~~blue~~ - designed for North side, and is devoted to early incidents in the Life of Our Lord. His Baptism at the center with Christ standing in the Jordan and Saint John the Baptist with his rustic cross on the shore holding the symbolic Shell of Baptism. The Descending Dove of the Holy Spirit casts down rays of Divine light.

Below is another incident related to the healing power of water, - the Miracle at the Pool of Bethesda. Our Lord commands the man to take up his bed and walk, while the Angel of the Pool hovers over it.

At the right is the Temptation of Our Lord. Satan shows Him the glory of the cities of the world and offers Him the crown of earthly power.

Below is another symbol of earthly power, - Our Lord and Nicodemus who could not give up his earthly possessions. The lantern implies his visit by night.

In the left lancet is the Calling of the Disciples to be Fishers of Men. Our Lord welcomes His Disciples who were fishermen.

Below is the Calling of Matthew. Our Lord beckons to him as he sits at the receipt of customs.

In the lancet head above is the Fish, symbol of Our Lord with the rebus of the Greek word, which also signifies - "Jesus Christ, Son of God, Saviour."

Opposite is the open Bible suggesting Our Lord's words during the Temptation; - "Men shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God."

In the tracery are Angels of Praise and Prayer with trumpet and censer, and at the top, the scroll with the significant words, - "Ecce Agnus Dei."

We are to under-emphasize the figure of Satan. Also they do not want the orange-red color. Perhaps conceal much of the figure of Satan in flames, as we did in our window for the Chapel of the First Congregational Church, LaGrange. Also be sure to avoid the orange-red, and use the pure ruby.

"...We have revised the figure of the devil, concealing the lower part of the figure in flames...keep this problem in mind and minimize the figure as it develops in the full size drawings and the actual glass." (Minimize the tail and the horns.)
