The other design is devoted to Saint Paul with the book inscribed with the cross, and the sword of his martyrdom, which is also the Sword of the Spirit.

In the principal medallion is his conversion on the Damascus Road. He kneels in the presence of the Heavenly Vision, shading his eyes, while his horse rears in alarm.

In the small base medallion he is stoned. Above, he preaches before The unknown God at Athens, and at the top, a symbol of the storm and shipwreck on the voyage to Rome.
