General Information To be devoted to Baptism theme - Saint John the Baptist -
like the one in Saint Chrysostom's Church, Chicago.

We have completed our study of the design for your window devoted to Saint John the Baptist, and are sending you the rough color sketch herewith.

Saint John, in rugged garments of the wilderness, holds the rustic staff and the symbol of the Lamb of God. On the shield above is the scroll with the text, "Ecce Agnus Dei"; and below is the shell of water of Baptism.

The lighted torch in the panel at the left suggests the prophecy "Thou child...shall go before the face of The Lord...to give light unto them that sit in darkness" (Saint Luke 1:76-79).

At the right is the knife of his martyrdom, and the martyr's palm of victory.

The fields are designed to harmonize with your other windows. ~~A place is provided for a memorial inscription across the base.~~
