General Information This pair completes the theme of the Four Archangels which began with the pair now in place.

They do not want to darken the church too much, so the background of these windows should be kept light.

As planned, this pair is devoted to Saint Raphael and Saint Uriel. Saint Raphael, - God Heals, carries the symbol of the fish and pilgrim's staff, recalling the story of Tobias. The wings are blue and the entire aspect is cool.

Saint Uriel, - Light of God, bears the symbol of the flaming sun. The dalmatic is of golden tones and the wings are red.

Each wears the Archangel's crossed chaplet.

The palette is a brilliant one, with luminous tones through the field to admit an abundance of illumination.
