General Information This is to be the alternate design from the Employees Window.

To symbolize the four Cardinal principles of the Legion - ~~Justice, Loyalty, Freedom and Democracy.~~ Justice, Loyalty, Freedom and Democracy.

We have Mr. Daley's copy of the Legion emblem (metal). This is to be returned to him.

We are to use a gold field with blue medallions and blue borders. The Legion's colors are blue and gold.

The principal symbol will be the Scales of Justice with two rings, of blue; above that, the star with rays descending from it (for ~~Justice~~ Freedom); Below the Scales symbol, will be the Wreath, as on the Legion symbol (for Democracy, and Loyalty; and below, the Legion symbol.

As planned, we have kept the color scheme principally in blue and gold, with just enough other colors to accent and complement the basic tones.

It is designed to symbolize the Four Cardinal Principles of the Legion. The Scales of Justice are represented in the dominant medallion. In the background we have indicated two rings.

Above is the Star of Freedom, with descending rays of Divine Light.

Below the Scales is the Wreath for Democracy and Loyalty; and, at the base, the complete Legion symbol.

Through the foliated border are flames of Devoted Zeal; and in the gold field, smaller stars of Steadfastness.

The Memorial Inscription reads: "In Memory of Our
Departed Comrades, Middlesex County Council of
The American Legion, 1960"

*Note: as this window is \$200 less than the Employees Window, simplify the background somewhat in order to show some distinction - but keep it in harmony with the Employee window and the windows in the side chancel.
