General Information To be devoted to Saint Mary and Saint John Evangelist.
Window "to correspond with the Brown-Tomlinson memorial as
regards price and treatment; and the Baptistry window as regards
colors. That is, they want the blue plan.

"Large portrayals of Saint Mary and Saint John;
In the medallions above their heads portrayals of the Annunciation above
Mary; and the Call of St. John from his trade as a fisherman (Saint
Matthew 4:21-22).

In the medallions below Mary: Madonna of Sistine Chapel; and "The Return from
St. Calvary" by Herbert Schmalz - Mary being led up some steps by St. John
and Mary Magdalene (see reproduction)

In the medallions below John: Saint John at the Raising of Jairus'
Daughter; ^{Peter} and John running to Joseph's Garden on Easter Day. (John 20:3-6)
Be sure to use lettering with each medallion and subject, as in the
Baptistry window.

Lily in the Kite.

As planned, it is devoted to the Blessed Virgin Mary and Saint John the Evangelist. Saint Mary bears the shield inscribed with Her traditional monogram, and below is the text, "Saint Mary, Mother of Jesus".

Saint John's shield is inscribed with his apostolic symbol the chalice from which issues the serpent or dragon, with the text, "Saint John, the beloved disciple".

In the medallion above, Our Lord calls him from his work as fisherman to be a fisher of men; with the text, "Follow Me".

The Annunciation is represented above Saint Mary, with the text, "Ecce Ancillia Domine".

In the first medallion below is the stained glass interpretation of the Sistine Madonna with the text, "My soul doth magnify the Lord"; and the Return from Calvary with Mary being led up the steps by Saint John and Mary Magdalene. *"He took her into his home."*

Saint John is again represented below his dominant figure, at the Raising of Jairus' Daughter, with the text, - "Damsel, Arise"; and still lower, Peter and John run to Joseph's garden on Easter Day; with the text, "They knew not the scripture".

The white lily of Purity is designed in the tracery member.

Lovely blue is predominant in the color scheme, with significant passages of ruby, and threads of gold and silver tying all together.

Across the base, accompanied by angelic figures, is the memorial inscription, - "To the Glory of God and in loving memory of Members of the Nye Family".

This window will beautifully complement and enhance those now in place and all will sing together in a harmony of color and light.
