General Information To be devoted to The Ascension, with a center figure of Christ, and single angels in the side panels.

See photograph of chancel window and designs for side windows.

They do not like long toes.

We have studied the group of balcony windows and are sending you a rough color sketch for them in the shape of the Assumption of Our Lord. He is designed in garments of brilliant white in the central panel, with angelic attendants in the panels at either side. Below them are grouped the Apostles.

Above are symbols of the Ten Commandments recalling the fulfillment of the Law and the prophets (St. John 24th), and the Verse of the Holy Ghost with the tongues of fire of Pentecost (The Acts 1st).

We have sketched the central pivoting section and have substituted metal ventilators in the lower part of each side panel, for better composition.

As designed, this window should cost four thousand, three hundred dollars. It could very well be divided into three separate materials.

If necessary, the Assumption could be left out, substituting a foliated pattern something like the lower part of the design for the aisle windows; reducing the cost to three thousand, six hundred dollars.

We have also sketched a typical pair of northern windows and one of these in the vestibule and are sending the rough color sketches.
