General Information *The window will be viewed by those who pass by in their
cars throughout the day and night. It will be illumined at night by spot
lamps within the church.

Architect prefers warm colors rather than too many blues.

The Te Deum theme - similar to the one for Concordia Lutheran Church,
Louisville.

Seated figure of Christ in center panel, with Saint John in the
medallion below representing Apostles;

left panel, a standing angel, with Isaiah in the medallion below
representing Prophets;

right panel, standing angel, with Stephen below, representing Martyrs.

In the tracery - above center panel, Hand of God and Dove of
Holy Spirit, completing the Trinity.
Angels in the side tracery pieces.

In ventilator sections, either a text or something simple.

* There is a duty of 7 1/2%; and on top of this there is a sales tax of 11% - bringing
the price of the window up to \$2505.82. They will add this!

As suggested, its theme is the Te Deum Laudamus. Christ the King is represented at the center with sceptre and orb surmounted by the cross symbolizing His domination over the world. A choir of six winged Cherubim and Seraphim are represented in the border around Him.

The hand of God from the cloud and the descending Dove of the Holy Spirit in the central tracery members complete the Trinity. In the four remaining ones and the lancet heads at either side are adoring Angels, - "To thee all angels cry aloud".

Three typical figures represent the Apostles, Prophets, and Martyrs. Saint John with his traditional symbol, the chalice and serpent, kneels below the radiant figure of Christ, - "The glorious company of the Apostles praise thee".

At the left is Isaiah with his symbol the tongs and coal of fire with which the Angel cleansed his lips, - "The goodly fellowship of the Prophets praise thee".

Saint Stephen with the martyr's palms near by is represented at the right, - "The noble army of martyrs praise thee".

Decorative architectural "canopy" suggests heavenly mansions, and the blue border is enriched with stars of divine steadfastness.

A space for a memorial inscription or an appropriate text is indicated across the base.

Architect and perhaps the Minister will come to see work in process.
