We have completed our study of the design for the Saint Luke window for the Children's corner, and are sending you the rough sketch, herewith. Its color is predominantly blue, and it will take its place in excellent relation to the others.

Emphasizing his aspect of the beloved physician, Saint Luke bears the caduceus symbol. Flames of divine zeal are represented in the side lancet heads and in the tracery quatrefoil, while stars of heavenly steadfastness accent the borders and fields.
