General Information To be devoted to the Parable of the Good Samaritan.

As planned, it is devoted to Our Lord's significant Parable of the Good Samaritan.

At the left the compassionate traveler comes to the assistance of the unfortunate man who has fallen among thieves. He has a water bottle to refresh him and dress his wounds.

The Priest and the Levite pass by above the wounded man. The Good Samaritan's donkey waits to carry him to the inn.

In the decorative architectural "canopy" similar to the other windows, are Angels of praise and prayer bearing trumpets and censers, while another member of the Angelic choir kneels in the quatrefoil above.
