General Information

Rest on Flight - Jesus with Doctors in Temple, Presentation (See sketches made for other windows.)

This would be the blue scheme.

Left panel: Rest in Flight - Mary and the Child resting under the bending palm tree, with Joseph standing looking on. Predella: The Flight into Egypt.

Middle panel: Young Christ with Doctors in the Temple Predella: Mary and Joseph returning to find the Child.

Right panel: Presentation in the Temple Predella: The Carpenter Shop.

As planned, it is devoted to the Presentation, the young Christ with the Doctors in the Temple, and the Rest During the Flight into Egypt.

Reading from the right, the ancient Simeon holds the Christ Child in his arms, while Mary and Joseph, with the offering of turtledoves in the basket, stand before him. Above is the ancient symbol of Purity, - the unicorn, and in the predella below, the young Christ working with Joseph in the carpenter shop.

At the center, Jesus disputes with the Doctors in the Temple, while below, Mary and Joseph return to find Him there.

At the left, Mary sits under the palm tree with the Holy Child, guarded by Joseph, while their donkey rests above. The Flight into Egypt is represented below, and above, is the lion, symbol of Our Lord, - "The Lion of Judah."

In the tracery members are Angels of Praise and Prayer with trumpet and censer, and at the extreme top, the seven branched candelstick of the Temple.

Across the base is the memorial inscription, -
"In Memory of David Dearborn Lapham and Joyce Gray Lapham."
