General Information Aisles: Gospel side, Life of Christ from S. John's Gospel. Epistle - His ministry, Miracles, Parables.

Make the design with the two medallions - one of the earlier windows made this way.

"The Good Shepherd" (Saint John 10:11)

This window to be devoted to "The Woman Taken in Adultery" (in the upper medallion; ~~John 6:3~~)
and The Man Born Blind (John 9:1-30) (in the lower medallion)

As suggested, the one for the Gospel side is devoted to Our Lord's Miracle of Healing the Man Born Blind; and the Good Shepherd.

The palette has a predominance of ruby, while the emphasis is placed on blue in the one for the Epistle side. It is our thought to alternate the arrangement and emphasis of color through the series.
