General Information (See photograph of opposite group in place - these are on either side of quite a small space.)

Both groups are devoted to the six Attributes of the Deity; this group is devoted to Love, the flaming rose; Mercy, the broken sword; and the scales of Justice. We have kept the fields light enough to admit an abundance of illumination.

Note: in the opposite window, we used colors that the donor requested to suggest the range from sunrise to sunset - the light silvery fields of the sketch, with tints of cool and warm colors from light blues to light golds and greens serve as a perfect background for the pure rubies and blues of borders and medallions.
