General Information The 10 aisle windows are to be devoted to the Joyful and Glorious Mysteries - Joyful: Annunciation, Visitation, Nativity, Presentation, Finding in the Temple. Glorious: Resurrection, Ascension, Descent of the Holy Spirit, Assumption, Crowning of Blessed Virgin Mary.

Sacristy/ windows each to have a symbol.

Window over altar to have Virgin and Child (reproduction to come from church)

Windows to be gentle, pretty, minimum of paint - 15th century style - something like the Comolli Mausoleum window. Nothing on the background, clear glass, little pt.

This is a small chapel - just big enough to take the windows - old-fashioned.
