General Information Theme: Christ before Pilate.

This window to be kept considerably simpler than our earlier window, which was \$1500, and on which we lost nearly \$600.

Figures are to be considerably smaller than the first window - see photostat of suggested arrangement. Figures to be very similar to those in the Newtonville, St. John's window.

To have a similar memorial inscription, and little related symbols in the base of each panel - the bag of silver and the scourges and pillar.

Color border to be the same as that in the first window, either red or blue; and the simple leaded fields to be in the same type and tones of glass as used in that window, but without the small symbols.

Following our telephone conversation, I am enclosing a very rough pencil sketch suggesting the sort of composition we could undertake in your windows for twelve hundred dollars.

The color border would be the same as that in the Campbell window, either red or blue; the simple leaded fields would be in the same type and tonus of glass as used in that window, but without the small symbols.

The two figures, Our Lord and Pilate, would be very similar to those in the window in Saint John's Church, Newtonville, of which you have a photograph. They would be in full color similar to the figures in the Campbell window.

A similar memorial inscription could also be included, and little related symbols in the base of each panel - perhaps the bag of silver and the scourges and pillar, as in the bases of the Newtonville window.

As planned, it is devoted to Christ before Pilate.

Below the dominant figures are related symbols, - the bag of silver and the scourges and pillar.

We have suggested a ruby border, although it could be blue if you prefer. The ruby generally serves best on the side receiving little sunlight, and the blue on a sunnier side.

We have indicated a space for a memorial inscription.

Note: Border to be changed to blue.
