General Information Theme to be "Come unto Me" similar to the window in Christ Church, Elizabeth City.

There are seven stained glass windows in the church with the following themes: The Annunciation, Visitation of Magi, Baptism of Christ, Resurrection, Christ the Good Shepherd, and two windows based on two phrases of the Benedicite. See 4 color prints sent by the Minister.

As planned, it is devoted to the theme of
"Come Unto Me", - Our Lord calling all people toward
Him.

Robed in garments of ruby and white, - ancient
color symbols of Divine Love and Purity, Our Lord
stands in an attitude of welcome above the troubled,
weary, and heavy laden.

Below a member of the Angelic Choir kneels in
prayer.

All are set in decorative architectural "canopy"
in harmony with your other windows.

They feel that the Christ figure is out of proportion - especially avoid
an over-emphasis on arms and hands.

They like the stronger, richer, deeper gold.
