General Information These windows to be a memorial to a five-year old boy, Scott David Taylor. He was born on Holy Innocents Day and died on the first Sunday after Trinity. These are the two themes that the mother wants in the windows - the Trinity window theme would be, "There is no fear in love." (I John 4:7-21)

Our thoughts center around the Lamb of God on Mount Zion from whence flows the Four Rivers of Life; with an Angelic harper kneeling below. This would be well related to the font.

For the balancing window, we suggest a figure of the young Christ in an attitude of welcome with a child kneeling in prayer before Him. This can be beautifully designed in medallion form with the lower figures not entirely enclosed in the medallion. Appropriate texts below would emphasize the symbolism.

The design to be conceived in rather simple terms, like our windows in St. Luke's Church, Denver in order to come anywhere near the appropriation of \$350 each.

These windows are slightly smaller than the rest of the windows in the church. The plan for the rest of the windows, 16 of them, is the Life of Our Lord.

Rector does not want the church too dark

Their palette is rich and colorful, but with sufficient passages of light glass to prevent the church from becoming too dark.

As planned, one symbolizes the theme from I John 4:18,- "There is no fear in love".

The Christ Child in an attitude of welcome is the dominant symbol, with a child kneeling in prayer at His feet. The child might well be a little larger, as is the lower figure in the other window.

There, the Lamb of God is represented on Mount Zion, from which flow the Four Rivers of Life; with a harper below. The suggested text is,- "They are without fault before the throne of God", - "Revelations 14:5.

With your approval of this general plan, we shall be glad to develop color sketches for side windows, and especially those devoted to the Annunciation and the Nativity.

We believe the Scott David Taylor memorials will cost at least five hundred and fifty dollars each, to make, but as you say they are smaller than the others, we will be glad to undertake them for five hundred each, to introduce the series and to determine our actual costs.
