The dominant central panel of this window represents Christ blessing little children. He holds one small child in His arms, while another comes for His blessing. The lamb suggests purity and innocence. In the flowering bush is a bird's nest with the protective mother bird watching over it.

Below, Our Lord is represented at table, in the home of His friends of Bethany, Martha and Mary. Martha serves while Mary kneels listening to His words.

In the left panel are the bride and groom of the marriage at Cana, blessed by Our Lord in His attendance. The six water pots suggest Christ's
