Blue Book

We have been studying the design for the Brodie memorial window and are sending you a rough color sketch setting forth our thoughts for it.

Symbolizing the suggested verses of the Ninety-first Psalm, we have represented the kneeling figure of David, sweet singer of Israel, with his harp, in an attitude of devotion and honor. He is enveloped in descending rays of heavenly light from the symbol of The Almighty in cloud forms. His refuge and fortress is symbolized by the surrounding "canopy" of turreted architectural forms in the ancient tradition of stained glass.

At either side are attendant Angels, members of the Heavenly Hosts.

A space can be provided across the base for a memorial inscription.
