As planned, the dominant theme of the first panel is the Creation, with the symbol of the Creator above the Sun, Moon and Stars, animals, and the principal figures, Adam and Eve. The lower medallion symbolizes the broken relation by the Expulsion from the Garden.

▷ The second panel represents Abraham's response to God as he journeys, with Sarai and Lot, to the new land. Below he builds the altar to worship God.
