General Information Aisle Window "Christ Blessing Little Children"

As planned, it is devoted to Our Lord blessing little children. He holds one small child in His arms while others stand in attitude of prayer and bring flowers to Him.  
Above is the Dove of the Holy Spirit and below, the symbol of the Font.  
A bird and flowers occur through the diam ond leaded field. This and the border colors could alternate through the series, with warmer fields and blue borders. Appropriate symbols would accompany each subject.

Herewith is our revised study for your window devoted to Our Lord Blessing little Children.

He holds one small child in His arms, while a mother kneels before Him holding another. Others come to Him, one in the attitude of prayer, and another bringing flowers.

Three children are designed in the medallion below, with the significant text, - "Suffer the little children to come unto me".

The descending Dove of the Holy Spirit is designed in the foliated border above.

Birds and flowers enrich the patterned field which is kept luminous to admit an abundance of light to the interior.
