General Information Both of these windows have Gothic heads. "We desire to
have them designed in our traditional manner and in keeping with the Reformers
window. The window on the side elevation to be designed to depict Saint
Augustine of Hippo. The window on the front elevation to contain Saint
Matthias."

Mr. Barnett writes: "My sight measurement of these windows is 82" long, and
12" wide. The window commences to narrow 17 inches from the apex of the

First, there is the one above the Reformer's window in the narthex, devoted to Saint Augustine of Hippo in Episcopal dress. Elements recalling the nave windows complete the enrichment, - the Lily, and the Angel, in foliated pattern.

The one in the front elevation designed in a similar manner is devoted to Saint Matthias, with his symbol, the book.
