The Iconographic Committee has selected a text as the subject of this window leaving the imagery to be drawn by the artist from the text, The text reads:

- Flower of Carmel
- Vine, Blossom-laden
- Splendor of Heaven
- Child-bearing Maiden
- None equals Thee

(Taken from the Ancient Prayer Floss Carmeli).
(The background, therefore, could be flowers, vines, buds, etc.). It is further suggested that since lilies and roses have been used in the Ambulatory windows that these flowers be avoided.
