General Information Make two designs (alternate treatment) - one with symbol of a musical instrument, and another with an angel member of angelic choir.

Ancient musical instrument to be the harp, lute, vielle or reber.

For the choir and organ windows, there are rough sketches, ~~one with musical instrument (the twelfth century psalterion), and an Angel with peal of bells. Another musical instrument or an Angel with harp might well be introduced, depending upon which plan you prefer.~~

They have accepted the design with the Angel figure. We are to prepare the companion sketch for the musical angel.

They like especially the angel with the harp - so follow this style of angel in both windows.
