General Information They would like a rough color scheme showing the side windows on each side - six in all - including the two now in place; and a color scheme for the great west window, - no subjects.

Dr. Cannon likes the chancel window, and is not entirely pleased with the flatness of the first two aisle windows.

They are also interested in having sketch suggestions for various vestibule windows of which O.E.S. took measurements.

and color notes. Of course the design may be considerably altered as themes and subject-matter is developed, so these sketches apply most directly to color arrangement.

The first from the transcript on the north side suggests the present Postcard window, with Ionian on the central figure.

The second predominates in golds and purples or mauve; while the third accents blue, with touches of red and tan.

On the south side, the second, next to the present Music window, accents the blue and gold, with touches of purple, recalling the opposite window and carrying the gold from the first.

The third, largely predominates in red, blue and green, in harmony with the opposite one, but introducing pleasant variation.
