General Information This window is designed to symbolize the Reformation, with the principal medallions representing Luther's Thesis nailed to the cathedral door; and the Ecuminical symbol.

The figures in the tracery suggest Martin Luther and ~~Constantine~~ Constantine I, who called the first council of Constantinople. In the lancet heads are John Calvin, and John Huss in flames; and below, Wycliffe and John Knox; Robert Brown and John Robinson
