General Information Make rough sketches, with cost suggestions - medallions in light simple fields - symbols of Faith, Hope and Charity.

Windows now have fine pebbled factory diffusing glass, white, and there is an outer window that is smaller, and the ones we are doing are inner windows. The outer window is smaller - about 6 inches all around, which means that there is a shadow all around the edge - all diffused - also one across the middle horizontally, and a slight one vertically in the center - just a diffused shadow.

Sometime we will probably have to figure on the two doorlights - one beside the chancel, and one in the entrance - 9 11/16" square sight.

Center panel to have the Flaming Rose of Charity; Right panel - Cross with rays to balance the anchor in left panel - This panel devoted to Hope.

We have also studied a typical Chapel window developing it in simple light foliated fields, colorful borders, and central symbol. Our thought is to devote the three windows to the Christian Virtues of Faith, Hope, and Charity, - the Anchor symbolizing Faith. Stars through the border suggest Heavenly Steadfastness. Color variations through the three windows will add interest without disturbing harmony.

As planned, one features the Cross of Faith and emanating rays of Divine light, and the flaming Rose of Divine Love and Charity. You have the sketch with the Anchor of Hope.

These three windows will be given added interest by the alternation of color arrangement, ruby and blue. They will be made at the reduced price for the three complete.
