As planned, it is devoted to Ruth of the Old Testament, with her gleanings and implications of the fields of Boaz. The little figure in the background might symbolize either Boaz or Naomi.

In harmony with the David design, the figure is set in an architectural "canopy" similar in character to many celebrated early windows.

The memorial inscription is suggested at the base. The word "laying" may be included, and there would be space for years of birth and death if required.
