General Information This opening is a rectangular - 13" x 30" sight.

Another rough sketch suggests a treatment for the small window just inside the narthex screen. Here we have indicated the Archangel Gabriel, with some text such as "Sing unto the Lord". (Instead of the trumpet, he might hold the fleur-de-lys of purity).

The design is kept light to insure abundant illumination for those entering and leaving.

This window could be equally well devoted to one of the other archangels - Michael with his scales, Raphael, the Guardian Angel; or Uriel, Regent of the Sun, - or, again, any of the saintly characters.

An appropriation of about two hundred sixty dollars is indicated.
