General Information The church is Georgian. All windows have provision for double glazing, so the clear glass protection can be left in place, setting everything from the inside.

(First two on each side nearest the entrance are in place, see photographs and color plates.

Remember: The bars in the protection glass on the first windows were in the wrong place. Be sure to fix them when the new windows are installed, and be sure to have them right with these new windows.

The third, devoted to the Nativity, again has the ruby accents with the Star of Bethlehem above, and the Ark of the Covenant below.

The symbols with the Presentation in the Temple (number four) are the Ma-di Monogram of the Virgin, and the Foyer of David, from the Litany.

With the Finding of the Child Jesus (number five) are the symbols of the seven-branched candlestick and the Chi Rho monogram of Our Lord.

The next (number eight) representing the Descent of the Holy Ghost upon the Apostles, has for its accompanying symbols the Descending Dove of the Holy Ghost, and the Commandments, the God-given Law of the Old Testament.

The next window devoted to the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven (number nine) bears the symbols of the Gate of Heaven and the Palm.

Finally, the Coronation of the Blessed Virgin Mary is accompanied by symbols of the Rosary (Queen of the Rosary) and the Vase of Roses, ancient symbol of Our Lady.
