As planned, it is devoted to the Saption of Our Lord. He stands in the Jordan with the descending dove outlined in the rays of divine light.

John the Baytist, in beir garment, is represented with his erossed shelf and shell of Baytism opposite others baytised by him, with an attendent angel above.

In the tracery quatrefoils other newbers of the engelic chair bear scrolls inscribed "Tale is my beloved Son".

A scrall for a possible memorial inscription is provided through the decorative architectural design below.

Criticisms of the design: We are to move the head of the Dove so that the bar does not cut it off at the neck.

Change the nimbus on Christ so that it doesn't look like a life-preserver - change from red to gold.

Change John Baptist crossed staff to shepherd's crook/

They do not feel that enough is made of the water at Christ's feet, and that it looks too much like the blue and white cloud effect at the top. Make more of the water - and be sure it looks different from the blue and white cloud design at the top.

Reverend Mr. Beckwich feel s that the faces in the Baldwin window are just right, and we should use this same type in this new window - they are a compromise between the earlier and more modern windows there.
