General Information Small figures or symbols, perhaps Apostles, or Prophets  
or later saints, symbols of S. Stephen  
or the Diocesan symbol -- ?

There are all small windows in a row,  
high on each side of the chancel, each about 12 inches  
wide by 18 inches high. Slightly pointed top. #49

Also 12 clerestory dormer windows in  
pairs each side of the church, 18 or 20 inches wide by  
54 to 60 inches high, slightly pointed tops, in wood  
sash. Inch wood muntins to be removed. #40

He would like small figures, or symbols,  
in the chancel windows; and simple colorful fields with  
emphasis on blue through the clerestory, probably accented  
with symbols, or possibly figures.

Discussed the Apostles, Prophets, later  
saints. Perhaps symbols of Saint Stephen and the Diocesan  
symbol.

They have some needle point covers with  
Diocesan symbols and Saint Stephen's, dalmatic, and three  
stones.
