This window is to be devoted to The Passion (Passion Week).

and is to be the Simpler type - should correspond to the Moses panel, but make a little more of the base medallion - instead of having the big lettering, have a little larger medallion in base with Gethsemane; and under the Crucifixion, the Flagellation - as follows.

Christ before Pilate,  
(a little figure of  
Pilate in background).

The Crucifixion

Gethsemane

The Flagellation.

Rector writes: "I would particularly like to have this window emphasized by reds and purples but completely, or even partially, in the other windows we have."

The opposite window on the west side is devoted to the Passion of Our Lord, beginning with Gethsemane, - "Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me".

Above, Christ stands bound, first before Caiaphas the high priest, and then Pilate, who washes his hands, (The little figures in the field).

The opposite panel records the flagellation, with Our Lord on the cross, above. His Mother, Mary and Saint John, the beloved disciple, are designed at either side. Saint John holds the book and pen as Gospel recorder.

Here we have emphasised the rubies and purples.

Note - Be sure to reverse panels so they will be in chronological order. Also reverse Gethsemane to face in.
