General Information On the southwest side, nearest the northwest aisle - symbol of the Paschal Lamb; and the one nearest the southeast side, symbol of the Crown of Thorns.

Set in very simple light leaded fields - in these two windows the fields are even lighter in pastel tones with decorative panels that helps to emphasize the vertical movement.
